

Bristol Medieval Studies Summer School 2025

Live and study in Bristol, a major medieval port city and a gateway to medieval Europe

The University of Bristol is working towards the creation of an exciting Summer School with a focus on Medieval Studies for 2025. Program description

This three-week intensive program will be hosted by the research community at our prestigious Centre for Medieval Studies. In addition to the opportunity to work with our world-leading medievalists, students will be offered field trips and workshops in situ thanks to our unique partner institutions in Bristol and the South West of England. These include the Bristol Archive, Bristol Cathedral, the Bristol Central Library, Berkeley Castle, Gloucester Cathedral, the Winterbourne Medieval Barn, the Royal Mint Museum, and the Bodleian Library in Oxford. Students will explore ideas at the heart of current debates on medieval studies and the humanities, while developing a strong understanding of the key research skills used by professional medievalists. By the end of the Summer School, they will have gained a deeper understanding of topics that will help them complete their degree.

Academic requirements: GPA equivalent to 60–63% on the UK scale, C on the ECTS scale, or 3.0 on a 4.0 GPA scale.

Subject requirements: we welcome applications from undergraduate and graduate students studying any subject, but the summer school is particularly suited to Arts, Humanities or Social Sciences majors.

Credits: upon successful completion of the program students will receive 10 UK academic credits, suggested as equivalent to 5 ECTS or 3 US semester credits.



2025 fees program dates and fees: three weeks, starting early or late June - to be confirmed.

Program fees around £3,500 - £3,600 - to be confirmed.

Discount: a 10% program fee discount for either:

- individual early-bird applicants;
- individual applicants from <u>International Partner Universities</u> and <u>Study Abroad</u> student mobility partners; or
- groups of 10 or more students attending a summer program from the same university.
